Bus Passes

City of Covina residents who possess a valid senior or disabled TAP card may receive subsidized monthly METRO and Foothill Transit bus passes when they sign up for the City's bus pass subsidy program. Proof of City of Covina residency is required to participate in the bus pass subsidy program. The City does not load regular or student TAP cards, and does not offer EZ passes for sale.

Prices Effective June 26, 2010

- METRO Senior/Disabled Local Bus Monthly Pass \$5.00 (a savings of \$9.00 off the regular monthly rate)
- Foothill Transit Senior/Disabled Local Bus Monthly Pass \$7.00 (a savings of \$15.00 off the regular monthly rate)

Bus passes are sold to eligible program participants from the 25th of the month through the 10th of the following month during regular business hours at the Finance Department counter at City Hall and at the Joslyn Senior Center.
